World-class adventure and standout culture are the unique calling cards that set Colorado apart. The state's breathtaking wild landscape boasts everything from natural hot springs, thousands of lakes and rivers, and nine incredibly diverse national parks and monuments to 58 mountain peaks that top 14,000 feet. It is all this plus a rich cultural heritage and thriving arts scene, a wealth of inventive dining experiences, and a plethora of wineries (73, to be exact) that make Colorado a destination not to be missed.

THE HOT SPOT: Head to Great Sand Dunes National Park and Preserve, home to towering sand dunes and cool mountain streams.

THE COOL STOP: Hit Conundrum Hot Springs for seclusion, scenery, and soaking in natural mineral hot springs surrounded by six of Colorado's 54 "Fourteeners."

THE GREEN IDEAL: The Boulder Outlook Hotel and Suites, one of the state's zero-waste hotels, offers cardboard recycling and composting receptacles in each room.
